- 2022 23 has seen a full programme of hockey across the activities of Gloucestershire HA
 - Men's Masters O60s two sides in EH cup
 - Women's and Men's Masters players involved in Club, Area and National sides
 - Full season of County (Player Pathway) DC and AC
 - Full season of schools competitions
 - Full season of U8, U10 and U12 Festivals as well as U10 and U12 In2Hockey county rounds

5. Reports – Chair (2)

- Second full season of Gloucestershire operating with the new EH governance structure
 - Counties no longer have any responsibility for leagues, umpiring or coach development
 - These all now managed and run by EH centrally or working with Areas
 - Counties responsible for local competitions including younger junior hockey and County Hockey (Player Pathway)
- Operation of the new structure has continued to have varying degrees of success
 - GMS started the season badly, but eventually recovered
 - Now covering all older Junior competitions at EH level as well as Area Adult and Junior Leagues
 - West communication has continued to be limited
 - Links to West only through the Junior Competitions Committee and the Masters Committee
 - Area and EH Forums now becoming established to improve communications
- Future
 - EH focus
 - ED&I (Equality, Diversity and Inclusion)
 - Development of hockey in state schools
 - Growth of Masters hockey
 - Need volunteers to run these initiatives
 - To define programmes and budgets
 - Funding will be a key factor

 - Looking at ways to improve the process and decision making
 - Agreed latterly to look at providing more financial support to junior players, coaches, Clubs and Schools

- Involved in the County Standing Committee National Working Group
 - Assisted the completion of the EH Membership Policy
 - This though did not help much in getting a definitive list of Gloucestershire members and their contact details
 - · Only achieved at the eleventh hour
 - Something which hopefully will be easier next season
 - Raised concerns over the lack of an overall IT strategy at EH
 - Exemplified by the latest changes to the County (Player Pathway) system with a move to the Club Buzz platform

- Finance Matters
 - i. Reserve Fund Target of @ £15k by end of 2029-30 season
 - there are different opinions on this at GHA Committee and the high level of GHA reserves has been raised at previous AGMs.
 The Player Pathway Team believe that setting a target would help the GHA Committee plan investment for initiatives such as the ones listed in ii below.
 - If we can agree the above then this will strengthen the case to approach West Hockey for support as they have stated reserves of £160k as of April 2022. Please note that reserves for counties in the West Area are unknown as England Hockey does not require counties to report or publish their reserves (which makes our Treasurer look pretty good as he reports our historic reserves to the AGM and they are published on the GHA website).
 - Please note that National Area stated reserves are @ £620k as of April 2022.
 - GHA Spending Strategy
 - The GHA Committee has drafted a funding policy that is likely to form the basis of the strategy detailing GHA plans over the next 5 years. The draft policy currently covers (in no particular order)

Proposed Annual Total

1. Support for players at Talent Academy

£2,000

2. Support for state schools for regional or national finals

£500

3. Support for affiliated GHA clubs for regional or national finals

£500

4. Support for GHA coaches (safeguarding, DBS, first aid and coaching)

£1,000

5. Coach development courses for club and state schools

£1.000

6. Support to increase the number of qualified umpires

£1.000
